

Major Games Appeal

1. Appeal Process

- 1.1 A player, who fails to be selected for the National Team pursuant to the criteria set out in the selection criteria, may appeal against omission from the team.
- 1.2 The appeal may only be made on the grounds stated in the Major Games Selection Policy.
- 1.3 Any appeal against any decision on selection or non-selection from the teams must be lodged within the stipulated timeframe and submitted to:

- 1.4 Failure to comply with the appeal time frame will result in the appeal being dismissed.
- 1.5 An appeal must be in writing (titled: Notice of Appeal filed by <Name>, <NRIC>) with appropriate and sufficient documentation and must be accompanied by a deposit of SGD \$100.00, payable to "Volleyball Association of Singapore". If the appeal is not sustained, the deposit will be forfeited.

2. Appeal Committee

- 2.1 The Appeal Committee shall comprise:

- 2.2 The members of the Appeal Committee will be formally appointed by the VAS Board. The Committee can introduce new members to contribute to the Committee as it deems fit, to a maximum of 5 members including the Chairman.
- 2.3 The tenure of the Committee will be aligned to the tenure of the existing VAS Board and will cease at the end of the Board's term.

- 2.4 The Appeal Committee shall:
- 2.4.1 Report to the Board via the Chairman of the Committee, who must be a member of the Board;
 - 2.4.2 Investigate and review any appeal case with a hearing within 3 days of receipt of Notice of Appeal, and make its decision thereafter;
 - 2.4.3 Provide the appellant a statement of reason for its decision within 3 days of hearing; and
 - 2.4.4 Not have the right to the reselection of the player. During the investigation, if the selection process is found to be incorrect, it shall make their recommendations to the VAS Board for a final decision.
