

**Volleyball Association of Singapore**  
**Major Games Selection Committee - Terms of Reference**

**1. Purpose & Objectives**

The purpose of the Volleyball Association of Singapore (VAS) Selection Committee is to act as the approving authority for selection of High Performance teams (indoor and beach).

In addition to this, the roles of the Selection Committee are also to: -

- Provide input into the selection criteria<sup>1</sup> for High Performance teams;
- Approval authority for final selection for High Performance teams;
- Oversee the team selection process for high performance teams in close consultation with the respective head coaches;
- Provide input into the selection of assistant coaches and head coaches for high performance teams (including age-group teams); and
- Any other matters relating to high performance teams' selection matters as deem relevant and appropriate by the Committee

**2. Committee Members and Committee Tenure**

The Selection Committee will report to the Board via the Chairman of the Committee, who has to be a member of the Board. The Committee members should consist of at least 2 members of the Board (including Vice President of High Performance) and at least 5 members in total.

Members (except Board members) will be formally appointed by the VAS. The Committee can introduce new members to contribute to the Committee as it deems fit, to a maximum of 7 members including the chairperson.

The tenure of the Committee will be aligned to the tenure of the existing VAS Board and will cease at the end of the Board's term.
